'I must go over the ground again,' wrote Edmund Blunden. His words count as an invitation to explore the old wartime landscape yourself. The following worksheets might help you to discover various sites.

- Menin Gate this worksheet assesses perception and knowledge about the Menin Gate
- a British military cemetery
 this worksheet can be used in any British cemetery;
 it makes no reference to a particular place
- French military cemetery Saint-Charles de Potyze worksheet for this site only (Zonnebeekseweg, 8900 leper) not usable in other French cemeteries
- German military cemetery Langemark worksheet for this site only (Klerkenstraat, 8920 Langemark-Poelkapelle) not usable in other German cemeteries



YPRES SALIENT EAST 1







Using your own coach, we travel through the eastern part of the notorious Ypres Salient. We stop at a French cemetery. Halfway through the excursion, we will walk across what was once noman's-land. Aerial photographs and remembrance trees make clear how close to each other the trenches really were. A series of now peaceful pools reveals their wartime origins.



Along the route, the following themes will be explored: remembrance culture (both British and German), medical care, the role of the landscape, country estates and their castles, the front, the underground war, multiculturalism,...

During this excursion, we visit the following sites:

- Saint-Charles de Potyze, French military cemetery
- Railway Wood RE Grave, British memorial to the 177th Tunnelling Coy
- · Bellewaerde Ridge & Liverpool Scottish memorial
- · walk in the wooded area hiding a number of mine craters
- Hooge, Eastern Salient visitors' centre
- Hooge Crater Cemetery, British military cemetery
- Menin Road South Military Cemetery, British military cemetery
- · Menin Gate, memorial to the missing



During the walk, by using this <u>application</u>, students will be able to see on their iPhone or tablet where exactly they are on the old front.


Schoolmatch.easier1418 is an online tool for schools that wish to start up an international project connected to the remembrance of the First World War and are looking for a suitable partner school in another country.


